

PROGRAM RULES

The miniPerc Training Program: A Bridge to Guangzhou- by Devicare & Dr. Zeng

The participation in the 1st Edition of the miniPerc Training Program: A Bridge to Guangzhou- by Devicare & Dr.Zeng necessarily implies full and unconditional acceptance of these rules by the participant.

1. PURPOSE OF THE CALL AND MAIN OBJECTIVES

The purpose of this call is to award a program to Spanish healthcare professionals with a recognized medical specialization in Urology, supporting their participation in an advanced clinical training program in Guangzhou, China.

The selected candidate will engage in a two-week immersive program dedicated to mini-Percutaneous Nephrolithotomy (PCNL), conducted under the direct supervision of Dr. Guohua Zeng, a globally renowned expert in endourology.

Exclusively aimed at Spanish urologists, the program is granted annually to one exceptional applicant. The main objective of this program is to offer an intensive academic and practical experience designed to refine surgical skills, improve clinical outcomes, and ultimately enhance the quality of care for patients with renal lithiasis.

This initiative promotes professional excellence, encourages international collaboration, and supports the advancement and dissemination of specialised surgical expertise within the urological community.

This program offers a unique educational opportunity to gain advanced clinical knowledge and additional benefits designed to enrich the professional journey of the selected candidate:

- Official Certification: receive a certificate of participation jointly issued by the hosting institution and the organizing body, validating their commitment to continuous medical education.
- Global Networking: connect with leading international experts in PCNL and build lasting professional relationships that can foster collaboration and career growth.
- Firsthand Surgical Experience: gain valuable insights into high-volume surgical environments and observe best practices in mini-PCNL performed by top-tier specialists.

2. MAIN SPONSOR AND COLLLABORATING INSTITUTIONS

The program is promoted and coordinated by Devicare, a recognised institution committed to the advancement of urological training and international medical exchange, who will be the main sponsor

In collaboration with The First Affiliated Hospital of Guangzhou Medical University, and under the scientific guidance of Dr. Guohua Zeng, an internationally renowned expert in percutaneous nephrolithotomy (PCNL), the program offers a unique opportunity for advanced clinical immersion in China.

The initiative reflects a joint effort to foster academic excellence, promote the globalisation of medical expertise, and support the continuous development of urologists through hands-on experience in high-level healthcare settings.



3. PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The selected candidate will participate in an intensive clinical and observational training program focused on mini percutaneous nephrolithotomy (mini-PCNL), under the supervision of a leading international expert in the field.

Duration of the Program

The program will take place from 10 to 21 November 2025 (inclusive), for a total of two weeks of full-time clinical immersion.

Training Location

The program will be held at The First Affiliated Hospital of Guangzhou Medical University in Guangzhou, China, equipped with advanced technology and specialized units in endourological procedures.

Financial Coverage

Devicare, as the main sponsor, will cover the management and cost of round-trip airfare between Spain and Guangzhou. Any other remaining expenses incurred by the program shall be covered by the beneficiary. Devicare reserves the right to determine all aspects related to air travel arrangements for participants. This includes, but is not limited to the flight itinerary, the class of travel, the choice of airline and the baggage allowance and any additional flight-related conditions.

4. ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Participation is open to all Spanish urologists.

Applicants must meet the following criteria at the time of submitting their application:

- Hold Spanish nationality.
- Possess an official medical specialisation degree in Urology, issued by a recognised institution in Spain or another EU member state, or provide proof of completion of the Urology residency (MIR) programme.
- Be member of Spanish Urological Association (AEU).
- Be actively practising in the field of Urology within Spain.
- Have sufficient proficiency in English, both spoken and written, to effectively follow the training programme (official certification is not mandatory but may be considered an asset).
- Commit to full participation in the training programme during the established dates.

Preference may be given to candidates with:

- Previous training or experience in minimally invasive urological techniques.
- Academic contributions (e.g., publications, presentations) in the field of endourology.
- International Lectures with partners.

The participants who do not correctly communicate their personal or contact details during the registration process, those whose application forms are incomplete, those that contain manifestly incorrect or inaccurate data, those that are submitted through means other than those indicated in these rules and/or after the deadline required by the organization, or outside the duration of the



program, or those that do not fulfil the stipulations of these rules, will not be considered valid, and will therefore be ineligible for the program. Likewise, candidates who have previously benefited from this program in past editions will not be eligible.

5. APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Participants must register on the website www.miniperctraining.com and complete the registration form with the following sections:

- Name of professional
- Last name of the professional
- Email address
- Telephone number
- Hospital affiliation

Moreover, once selected, the applicant will be required to submit the following documents in digital format:

- A scanned copy of a valid National ID (DNI or NIE).
- Official certification of medical specialization in Urology, or alternatively, a provisional certificate confirming completion of the Urology residency program (MIR).
- An up-to-date curriculum vitae (CV).
- Proof of English language proficiency (if required for participation in the program).

Applicants who do not meet the eligibility requirements outlined above will not be considered valid and will therefore be ineligible to benefit from the program.

6. TIMELINE AND SELECTION PROCEDURE

The selection process will follow the timeline detailed below:

• Call for applications opens: 1st January 2025

• Application deadline: 31st July 2025 (23:59 CET)

• Evaluation of applications: 16th–30th September 2025

• Notification of the selected fellow: 1st October 2025

The final decision will be officially communicated to the selected candidate by email and will also be published on the official website (www.miniperctraining.com).

Applications received after the deadline or found to be incomplete will **not** be considered under any circumstances.



The selected candidate will have a maximum of **seven (7) working days** from the date of notification to confirm their acceptance of the program. If the applicant does not confirm their acceptance of the award by this deadline, they will lose their place, and an alternative candidate will be selected instead.

Once acceptance has been confirmed, any cancellation or failure to attend the program, regardless of the reason, will require the awardee to reimburse Devicare for the management and cost of the round-trip airfare. This condition is binding and applies unless duly justified and accepted by the organising body.

7. GENERAL CONSIDERATIONS
